

Make a Creative Cake!

Baker Makers and Boxitects working together.

Decorating cakes takes a lot of practice. Sometimes bakers practice on Styrofoam cakes to hone their skills. Here is one way you can practice decorating a creative cake, without baking.

Supplies:

- Cardboard boxes that are different sizes (minimum two)
- Tape
- Glue
- Craft Paint
- Decorations such as construction paper, tissue paper, sequins, stickers, glitter, pom poms

1. Tape each box closed.



2. Stack the boxes so they are in order of largest to smallest. Glue the boxes together.



3. When the glue has dried, paint the boxes like you would decorate a cake. You can drip the paint to look like icing.



4. Decorate! For example, throw on sequins like sprinkles or make cake candles by attaching yellow or orange tissue paper to a construction paper tube.
